What is Home Health Care?

Home Health Care is the provision of health care in the patient's home. It is a team of healthcare professionals, patient, families and caregivers under the supervision, collaboration and ongoing directions of the patient's personal licensed physician.

What are the benefits of Home Health Care?

Home Health Care includes several skilled healthcare services provided to a patient on a one-on-one basis. Different level of treatment, training and education are customized to patient's needs. Families, friends and caregiver are all involved in the care of the patient. Patients discharged to home from a healthcare facility is assured of continuity of skilled care.

Who may receive these Services?

Anyone can qualify for home health care services as long as the criteria for admission are met. This will be determined by your physician and the skilled agency staff who will do an initial assessment.

Who pays for these services?

Approved services are covered 100% by Medicare and Medi-Cal. Private insurance coverage varies with individual policies. Self pay or private pay are handled on a case to case basis. We process insurance verification, eligibility and submit claims on patient's behalf.

Services Offered

Under physician's direction and supervision, the following services can be provided in the home on intermittent basis:

Skilled Nursing Services

Nurses combine the science with the art of caring. Nurses are qualified to provide the following services:

- Wound Care (Wound Vac)
- Treatment & Injection
- Enteral Feedings
- Catheter Care
- Ostomy care and instructions
- Glucose monitoring
- Intravenous treatment: (i.e., TPN, Antibiotics, Pain management, Hydration, Chemotherapy)
- Assessment, evaluation, teaching & reassurance
- Pre/Post Surgical Care
- Care for Chronic medical conditions
- Blood drawing & Specimen Collection

Home Health Aide Services

Home Health Aide is available to help with the patient's personal care and hygiene needs and to provide light house keeping services.

Assist patient with safe ambulation, transfers, meal preparation and home safety skills under SN supervision

Social Services

Medical Social Workers help patients and their families cope with personal and emotional impact of illness or disability. The Social Worker will also help locate financial resources and community assistance such as home meal delivery or support groups.

Therapy Services

Special therapy services are available for patients requiring rehabilitative care and include:

Physical Therapists

Provide physician-prescribed treatment aimed at development and restoration of muscle and joint function. Establish Home Exercise Program(HEP)

Occupational Therapists

Help patients regain the skills necessary for self-care and the activity of daily living. Therapeutic exercises for upper extremity function, muscle strengthening/coordination

Speech Pathologists

Assist patients with impaired communications skills to regain those skills or to learn alternative ways to express their needs and feelings.
